HOW SAINTS' BREW STARTED: In 2007, Father Gene Asbury wanted to give the food insecure and homeless residents of Tupelo a welcoming place to sit in the early hours of the day. He brewed coffee, provided some fruit and pastries, but more than anything he gave them a place to seek refuge for a little while. What started as an open door and a hot cup of coffee has grown tremendously.

CURRENT: Today we serve around 90 hot meals each weekday morning that is staffed by 50 volunteers. In addition to having a plated breakfast, we offer our guests:

- Fresh fruit
- Cereal (donated)
- Donated hygiene products
- Free library
- Change of clothes when needed
- Resource board with other non-profits information
- Community event postings
- Distribute seasonal items such as gloves, hats, and coats during the winter months
